

Can the Living Talk to the Dead?

(Note: This sermon is about spiritism. It does not address the state of the dead specifically. That is covered in Sermon 14. Care should be taken not to make statements about the state of the dead not biblically substantiated until Sermon 14. This sermon is based on the biblical counsel that prohibits communication with the dead.)



The idea of talking to the dead seems to fascinate many today. It's the subject of movies, novels, and serious news reports. Books on mediums and their activities even top best-seller lists. Communication with another world, or with those who were once among us, captivates the imagination of many.



But are psychics and mediums right when they say they can put us in touch with the souls of the loved ones we've lost in death?



Can the spirits of the dead take possession of living people, using their bodies, their voices, their minds, to act and speak?




What we are talking about this time is one of the most serious matters that any of us may ever be called upon to meet.



And it is so serious that it can be truly called a life and death matter.

Our eternal salvation may be at stake, so we must be sure about this.

How can we really know for absolute certainty whether an experience we have is genuine and real—or false and dangerous?



The answer is that in the Bible, Jesus gives us the truth!



God in His word has clearly condemned spiritism and He has forbidden any attempt on our part to communicate with the dead. Notice the warning that God gave to His people about consulting a person who tries to talk to a "familiar spirit."



(Text: Leviticus 19:31) Leviticus 19:31:"Give no regard to mediums and familiar spirits; do not seek after them, to be defiled by them:



I am the Lord your God."



(Text: Deuteronomy 18:10-12) Before the people of Israel went into Canaan, they were strictly instructed, "there shall not be found among you... a witch,




or a charmer or a consulter with familiar spirits or a wizard or a necromancer.




"For all that do these things are an abomination unto the LORD..." Deuteronomy 18:10-12, KJV. God knows that people who consult with familiar spirits would cause His people to be mislead and so He told them this:

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Erobus 22-18 "You shall not permit a sorceress to live."	(Text: Exodus 22:18) "You shall not permit a sorceress [witch] to live." Exodus 22:18

Their only purpose, I repeat, their only purpose, is to deceive you and turn you away from Jesus and cause you to lose your eternal salvation.



It should make your hair stand on end, send shivers up and down your spine, and cause you to put distance between yourself and the "spirits."

If you believe that the dead are alive, you are wide open to be deceived and lost, because you haven't seen anything yet!

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Yes, Satan's deceptive power is so great that he can impersonate others, even appearing as a good angel!



(Text: 2 Corinthians 11:14)"And no wonder! For Satan himself transforms himself into an angel of light."2 Corinthians 11:14.



Have you wondered how a person can talk with someone who looks, talks, acts like a person they knew before death? The Bible says it is because Satan (and his angels) are so intimately acquainted with our traits and personalities.



They can impersonate any person who has ever lived. It is absolutely frightening to think that good people can be thus deceived and drawn into Satan's embrace, thinking all the while that they are enjoying the comfort of a departed loved one!



But this Scripture reveals something even more sinister: Satan himself will seek to impersonate Jesus.

Can you imagine how multitudes will be deceived because they do not know the truth of the second coming of Jesus?

Is it any wonder that Jesus gave such a serious warning about this very thing?

And Jesus answered and said to them: Take heed that no one deceives you.	(Text: Matthew 24:4, 5) "And Jesus answered and said to them: 'Take heed that no one deceives you.'"

Phave seen a departed loved one alive.	But someone may be saying-or you may know someone who says, "I have seen a departed loved one alive."



Someone else may insist, "I have talked to my departed husband."



Still another, "I lost my son in a terrorist attack, but I visit with him, talk to him, and he is a great comfort to me." What did God tell us? Don't talk to the dead – and that "spirits" would DECEIVE if possible the very elect. Millions will be deceived. Why? Because they trust more in their feelings, senses, and experiences than in the Word of God.



Why are the "elect" not deceived? Because they believe Jesus. They trust the sure Word of God instead of their senses, feelings, and experiences.



This is the issue:



will we accept God's truth,



or will we believe Satan's lie?



Only those who have fortified their minds with the words of the Bible will be able to stand against the overwhelming tide of deception that is already beginning to flood the world. We need to know these things and believe them with a resolute will, and not allow any experience, feeling, or "appearance" dissuade us from the truth.



Perhaps you have wondered about "near-death" experiences, in which people who have been pronounced clinically dead have been revived



and report that they found themselves hovering in the hospital room looking down at their own body—



or that they saw a bright light and Jesus or an angel beckoning them to come.

Some even report having seen a departed loved one on the other side of death.

Only with the truth of God's Word can we detect the falsehoods and be safe from deception.



We can make a fateful decision when we base it on our senses, our feelings, our experiences—rather than on the Word of God, the Bible.


There are just so many false beliefs that prevail about death around our world.



Take reincarnation, for example.

Millions believe that when a person dies, he is reborn in another form, yet he never knows which.

It quite possibly could be as an animal, such as a cow, rat, or snake.

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The self is absorbed into the universe as a drop of water is absorbed into the ocean, with complete loss of identity.

	The Barong advances toward them, and they back away. He shrieks and turns, and the men run after him, striking the air and trying to cut him down.

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The Barong stops and turns to face the men.

They stop. He advances one step, and they retreat one step. This is repeated, back and forth, time and again, until the six men get whipped up into such a wild state of frenzy they lose control. It is not uncommon for one or more to throw his kris and hit a bystander by mistake.

At this point, men from the village come up behind the men, wrestle them to the ground and pour water on them as they wretch. Finally, they shake their heads as though coming out of a trance, get up and walk off toward their huts, while the Barong walks away in the opposite direction.

What does it mean?

It is a religious festival in which men act out their beliefs. The Barong represents God, and the six men represent evil. According to their superstitious belief, there is an eternal struggle between good and evil.

Neither wins—it is always a draw.



I am so thankful for Jesus, the Resurrection and the Life, aren't you?



Yes my friends, there's one voice from beyond the grave that is speaking to us. That's the voice of Jesus, the One who died for us but rose from the dead! [Suggested Prayer]

"Dear Lord Jesus, tonight we've learned that we can't trust just any voice. We can't trust just anything that's supernatural or spiritual. But tonight we thank you that we can trust your voice speaking to us in Your word. Thank you for impressing us with your truth. Thank you for knocking on our heart's door. Tonight, Lord, we want to open that door and let you in. We want you to be the One who is speaking to us, who is comforting us, and who is guiding us. We want you to be Lord of our life and owner of our hearts. You see each heart bowed before you here tonight. You know each one, each need, each heartache, each desire. Tonight I pray that you will bless each one for the decision they have made for you. Keep them from deception and temptation, Lord. And keep them ever listening to your voice and studying your word, we pray, in Jesus' name, Amen."
